



## Introduction

This document includes the changes that are being implemented in the 2.5.40 release of ZooEasy. For each change, the number of the wish or incident is shown, as is also used in communication with end users, the description and consequences for use.

## Changes

No.	Description	Consequences for use
16	<b>Tab focus after horizontal scrolling within details</b>	If the details of an animal, combination, contact and/or result are opened, the number of available tabs may exceed the width of the ZooEasy Online application. In that case, a horizontal scroll bar is displayed below the tabs. By sliding this bar to the right, invisible tabs can be displayed. Selecting a tab ensures that the focus remains on that tab and does not slip back to the tab with the index data.
804	<b>Age in days until 1 month</b>	Until an animal reaches the age of 1 month, on the tab index data, the age of the animal is displayed in days. This value (number of days) can also be found in the export of data containing an animal that is less than one month old.
845	<b>Changing manager e-mail address</b>	In the Management menu, Accounts tab on the account list sub tab, in the details of an account, the mail address of the manager's account can only be changed by the manager themselves. On the Settings tab of the Management menu, this can still be done by other users with rights to the Settings tab. Managers of administrations who give others rights to add accounts can thus prevent these other users from modifying the email address of the manager's account.
765	<b>Trial breeding pair from animal detail tabs</b>	If a user is allowed to create a trial breeding pair in the breeding pair menu, the Trial Breeding Pair link is also



		<p>displayed in the detail view of an animal. Clicking on that link displays the usual trial breeding pair screen and the pedigree number of the underlying animal is already displayed in the appropriate parent field.</p>
836	<p><b>Gender of added animal pre-entered based on search for (missing) parent</b></p>	<p>If, when searching for a parent from the animal detail or pedigree view, the parent does not appear to be present, it can be added. When clicking the Add link, the search for the parent is taken into account and the gender of the animal to be added is pre-filled accordingly.</p>
794	<p><b>Showing pedigree from relationship percentage matrix</b></p>	<p>Clicking in a relationship percentage matrix or breeding advisory matrix on a cell displaying the percentage or breeding advice, opens the trial pedigree screen based on the parents of row and column. The respective parents are filled in which makes it easy to calculate percentages and/or display the pedigree.</p>
846	<p><b>Report template prefixes to retrieve owned by- and bred by animals from a contact</b></p>	<p>Functionality has been added to the report templates that can retrieve data from the database via an MS Word (*.docx) file, using merge fields. This allows retrieving for a contact the animals bred and/or owned by that contact. This functionality works similar to the way offspring can be retrieved. Prefixes BR_ (bred animals) and OW_ (owned animals) can be placed in a table for animal related fields. Eg: \$OW_RegistrationNumber\$, \$OW_Name\$, \$OW_Born\$.</p> <p>The animals for which it is set that the contact is the owner are collected. Of those animals, one under the other (per animal a new table line), per merge field the corresponding value is retrieved and displayed. If no animals can be found at a contact for the corresponding prefix, the merge fields are deleted and an empty line is displayed.</p>
687	<p><b>New module: multiple species of animals</b></p>	<p>The application has been made suitable to register the data of several different</p>



	<p>animal species within 1 administration, without the need to register all data within 1 animal species. On the Settings tab of the Management menu a new tab Animal species has been made available. On this tab the administration can be extended with additional animal species. The species chosen at registration is the main species that cannot be removed. Other animal species can easily be added and/or deleted. When deleting a species from the list of selected species, after confirming, all data of that species is deleted. Please note that here too, 'gone = gone' applies. After selecting an additional species, a pull-down menu is displayed next to the language in which the application is displayed, showing the species that are selected in addition to the one shown. This drop-down menu can be used to change species.</p> <p>Animal-specific settings can be applied per species. Examples are colors, breeds, extra fields, logbook categories and report templates, but also role settings that are species specific. For example, the (non-)use of (call) names for species laying eggs can be set for each selected species. Animal species specific settings can be found in the menu Animals, Breeding Pair, Results and Reports. Menus such as Contacts and Finance are generic.</p> <p>This module is a paid module. When the subscription is renewed, the number of species in use is determined and the maintenance fee for the number of species is added to the price of the subscription.</p> <p>For customers who use the modules 'Waiting list', 'Stud request', 'Import Raad van Beheer', 'MeanKinship' and/or 'Webservices' it is not (yet) possible to use the module multiple species.</p>
